


How to Check Computer's IP Address

Windows NT, 2000, and XP

To see what IP address, default gateway, and subnet mask your computer is using:

1. Click the Start button and select All Programs (XP) or Programs (NT and 2000).
 2. Select Accessories, then Command Prompt (2000 and XP), or Command Prompt (NT).
 3. At the command prompt, enter: **ipconfig**
 4. To close the command prompt, enter: **exit**

The IP address will be a series of numbers following the pattern **xx.xxx.xxx.xxx** for example **156.56.27.32**
