

PHOTOSUITE III SE

A Full-Suite Approach

MGI PhotoSuite III SE is separated into seven activities: Get, Prepare, Compose, Organize, Share, Print and Browse. These are the essential functions for working with photos on a PC and the Internet.

Get lets you retrieve photos from a digital camera, your hard drive and other sources. Prepare contains PhotoSuite III's powerful photo-editing tools. Compose helps you choose templates to create business projects or ideas for the home, from stationery to yard-sale signs. Use Organize to keep track of your photos by sorting and storing them in creative albums.

Share includes options for saving your artwork and for sending it to friends. Print your creations at home or connect to a photo lab on the Web. Browse is PhotoSuite's gateway to the Internet, letting you conveniently search for images from within the PhotoSuite program.

Get your Photos from a Variety of Sources

Retrieve photos from a variety of peripheral sources, such as digital cameras, scanners, the Internet or from online photo services.

Also get photos from your hard drive, floppy drive, CDs, DVDs and other removable storage media.

Many photo-finishing retailers offer the option of placing your photos on the Internet. Use PhotoSuite III to retrieve photos from an online service, such as Kodak PhotoNet Online. An e-mail notifies you when your film has been processed and your photos are ready to download.

Also use PhotoSuite III to create a new image. Start with the blank canvas, then add or create the art you want.



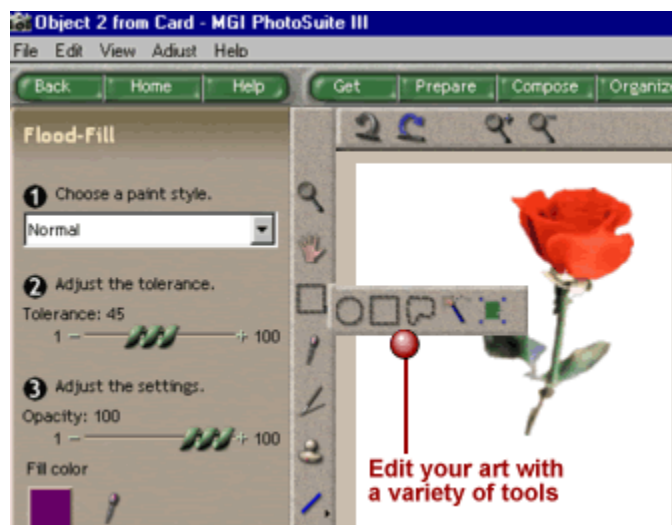
Editing Tools

PhotoSuite's editing tools let you repair and manipulate your images.

Straighten an image or to cut out unwanted portions with Rotate and Crop tools.

Touch up and repair photographs, as well. Use editing tools to fix and remove problem areas, such as red eye, blemishes and scratches. Then enhance images using special effects, such as Emboss or Mosaic.

Touchup filters and effects come with a Preview check-box, so you can see the results before clicking on the Apply button.

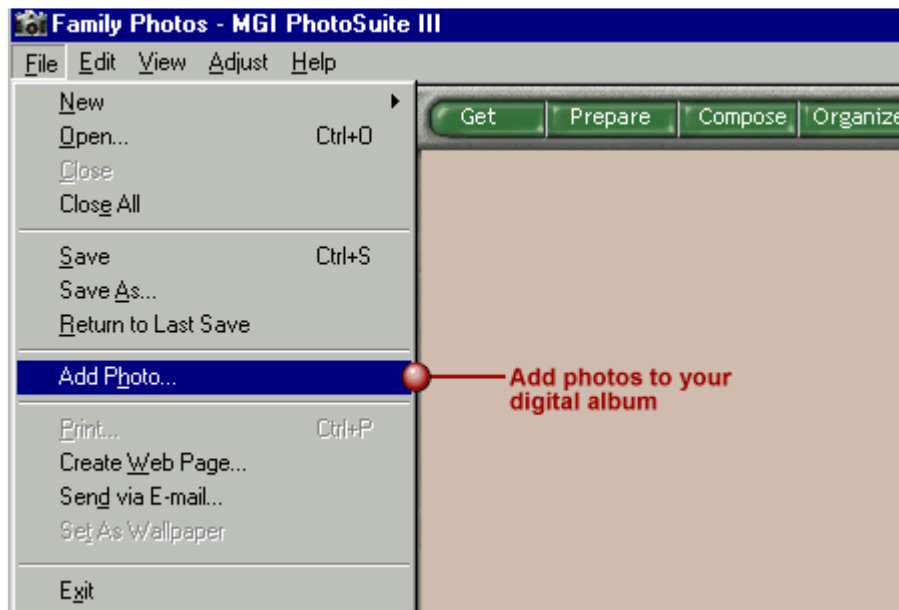


Get Organized

Handily store and retrieve photos integrated with clip art, videos and even sound using PhotoSuite III's functional electronic albums with powerful keyword-search capabilities.

Select Organize to access a new Master Album that keeps track of all your digital albums. Create individual albums to organize photos and other multimedia content into thumbnail (or miniature) sketches, adding descriptions to each. Then sort or search the albums and photos, based on the descriptions entered.

While the most obvious choice for albums is photos, you can also use albums to store sound and video files.

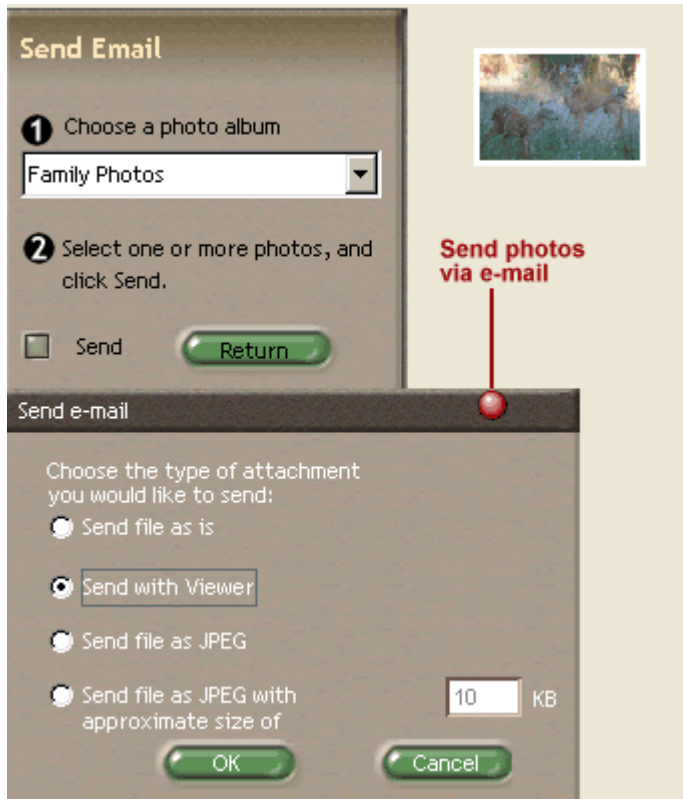


Show and Tell

Use the Share activity to save your files and then e-mail a photo, album, project or slide show to family, friends or business associates.

Items can be e-mailed as is, as a .jpg (photo image) file or as a PhotoSuite III e-mail slideshow complete with sound and packaged in one, self-contained executable file. Use slide-show capabilities to create multi-media presentations complete with sound effects, transitions, voiceover narration and music.

Photos can also be uploaded to an online photo service, converted into Web Pages or saved as Windows wallpaper.



Print your Images

After creating the image you want, print out your selection at home or connect to the Web to utilize an online photo lab.

Select "Print Multiples" to print your photos or projects on a prearranged template. PhotoSuite places and automatically resizes selected photographs into template "cutouts." Select from options that include printing to specialty papers by Kodak and Avery-Dennison.
